Letter writing

Features of a letter:

The sender's address, the date, the greeting - Dear..., introduction organised into paragraphs, conclusion, sign off with name

Prefixes – a letter or group of letters added to the front of a word to change the meaning of the word. They are not words by themselves.

Examples: re – un - dis - mis - anti- super- over- auto-

happy – unhappy like – dislike

Present perfect tense –

Explanation:

I have walked

You have walked

He/she/it has walked

We have walked

You have walked

They have walked
