POR: Poetry pie and Egyptian Cinderella

In English, we will be looking at poetry and different poetic features such as alliteration and rhyme. We will then write our own poem based on poems from the book poetry pie. After our poetry unit we will be looking at the story the Egyptian Cinderella and writing our own version using subordinating conjunctions, a or an correctly and different sentence types.

In Reading we will be looking at different poems for the first two weeks and using our VIPER skills in order to explore their contents. After that we will be looking at the book The Hodgehea written by Dick King-Smith our Author of the term.

PΕ

This term our PE day will be on Wednesday and children will do dance. They will learn to move safely around an area and learn to move in time to music.

History

Our History topic continues this term by looking at the home life of the ancient Egyptians. We will look at the roles of Eavptian men, women and children. We will explore deeper the beliefs of the ancient Egyptians about life after death and explore the hierarchy of ancient Egyptian society. We will then prepare a written piece answering our termly question, who were the ancient Egyptians in order to bring our learning together.

French

In French this term children will learn classroom instructions in French. After this lesson all instructions will be given in French for example to look, listen and read. They will also learn more conversational French being able to ask how people are and to respond when being asked.

Music (Ukulele)

As part of our music curriculum we will have a tutor come into school to teach the children how to play the Ukulele. We will use Charanga in order to focus our musical learning.

Maths

In maths we will be continuing to secure our knowledge on place value. We will understand the value of hundreds, tens and ones within a number. We will also be looking at adding and subtracting multiples of 10, bridging through 100. We will then move on to 10 more and 10 less than a number. The final unit this term will be measuring length which will include measuring in mm, cm and m. We will understand the difference between height and length



Art

In Art we will be looking at Egyptian patterns, copying patterns and creating patterns. We will look at mono printing, colours and colour wheels and different brush types.
