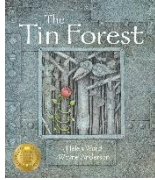


English

French

This term we will continue to discuss online safety. We will also learn how to construct and send an email.

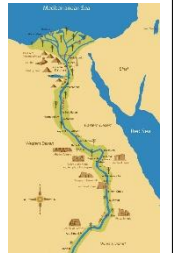
Science

Our Science this term is based on plants. We will learn to identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers

Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant. Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants. Explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.

Geography

In Geography we will be learning all about rivers. We will explore what a river is, their features why they are useful, looking at examples including recapping on the river Nile and looking at the importance of dams. We will also look at the dangers our rivers face.
