In P.E. we will be practicing athletics skills. Learning how to sprint, jump and throw different objects.

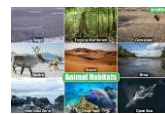
## **Term Five** **Where are the hot** **and cold places** **around the world?** **2024-2025**

## **Art**

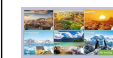
### **Collage**
