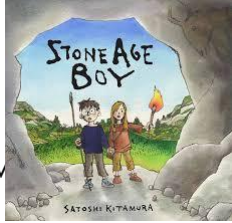


English.

In English this term we will be looking at the story of stone age boy. We will be using the text to write a short story and a set of instructions. Our grammar focus will be revising subordinating And co ordinating conjunctions and inverted commas for speech. In instruction v be using adverbs and prepositions.



French

In French we will be learning to say the days of the week and months of the year..

Maths

In maths we will be looking at right angles and parallel and perpendicular lines. We will also practice the four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division,

What was it like in the stone age?

History/ Geography

This term we will be looking at the stone age. We will look at stone age men as hunters and gatherers, look at farming in the stone age, we will look at what we can learn about stone age life from Skara Brae and look at stone henge.

Guided Reading

In guided reading this term we will be looking at the book Ug- boy genius of the stone age, cave Baby and stig of the dump and some non-fiction texts based on the topic of the stone age.

Science

In science pupils will, group and sort rocks according to their properties. We will be naming and describing different types of rocks. Final we will see that soil is made from rocks and organic matter.

ART

In art we will be learning a variety of sketching techniques to sketch Stone age tools and houses to eventually build a stone age structure.

RE

The Journey to Emmaus. The meaning of the story, the connection with Mass. How artists have shown the story The Ascension. The meaning of the story. What instructions does Jesus give. Trinity. We will explore how the Trinity is represented through imagery and music. We think how Trinity is used in Mass. The Early Church (Acts of the Apostles) and its work including the role of Mary. We look at images and statues of Mary and importance of Mary. You should be able to make a link with the Eucharist. Summary piece: look at the different types of writing in the Bible mainly of the New Testament.

Music

This term we will continue to learn to play the Ukulele

Computing

This term we will be looking at coding and safety managing information. Use flow charts, timers, code, test and debug, produce interactive scene.

PE
