Reading.

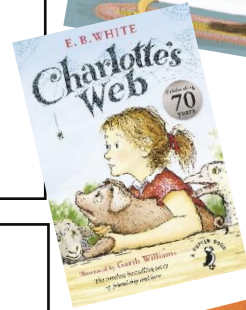
We will continue our reading sessions based on VIPERS. We will be reading the book, there's a pebble in my pocket along with other non-fiction texts.
