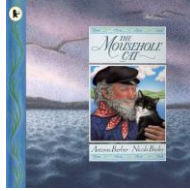


English

PE

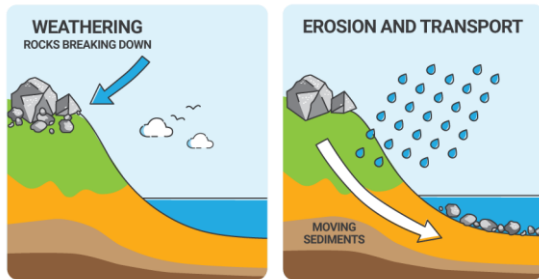

Science

In science we will be learning all about Light. Children will learn to recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light_notice that light is reflected from surfaces_recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes_recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object_find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change

Geography

In Geography we will be looking at the topic of coasts. We will look at what a coast is, how they are formed, what the dangers are to our coastline, how we can protect them, how coasts are similar or different and how coasts have changed over time.



French

We will continue to use French instructions that the children learnt in the previous terms. We will then get to know French numbers up to 20.

Music (Ukulele)

As part of our music curriculum we will have a tutor come into school to teach the children how to play the Ukulele. We will use Charanga in order to focus our musical learning.
