Preparing to start School

As part of the transition to school we are starting with 2 'taster' sessions to meet the teacher.

Tuesday 8th July 2025 Thursday 10th July 2025



These sessions will run from 9.30am - 11.00am



All children should attend these sessions.



Starting School in September All the children will start school on a part-time basis for weeks 1 and 2.

A gentle introduction helps the children develop relationships with staff and other children.

Home Visits - 2 members of staff visit you and your child at home to help us build a relationship with you and your child.

The First Day! Morning routine:

- book bag into their <u>own tray.</u>
- Placing <u>water bottles</u> in the classroom.
- coat into <u>locker</u>.
- find their <u>name card</u> to self register.
- settle to an activity of their choice.

We need all parents to support children with the new routines.
